## **Kempsey West Public School How to use the Traffic Lights**



If a child displays an inappropriate behaviour in class that is disrupting the class and impeding the learning of others:

- 1. Give the child a verbal warning, informing them that if this behaviour continues, their name will be placed on the traffic lights. For example: "XXXX you are not being respectful, responsible and safe in our classroom. If this continues, your name will be written on the green light."
- 2. If the child continues to display inappropriate classroom behaviour, place their name on the *green* traffic light.
- 3. If the child still continues to display inappropriate classroom behaviour, move their name up to the *orange/yellow* light. Inform the child that if they continue to display inappropriate behaviour, they will be sent to another classroom for reflection.
- 4. If the child continues to display inappropriate classroom behaviour, move the child's name to **reflection** on the *red* traffic light. Please send the child to your buddy class with SLSO for the student to be in the reflection class for a short period of time.
- 5. If the child returns from time out and continues to display inappropriate behaviour in the classroom please refer to executive. Please ensure after a student has gone on to the red traffic light or behaviours continue you add an entry to Sentral, well-being.

After lunch and recess all students are removed from the traffic lights and start fresh.
